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- District Engineer: *Craig A. Smith & Associates* PS1 and PS2 Electrical Engineering

 Design Update
- Status of Electrical Engineering Plans for Pump Stations 1 & 2 (Mr. Larry Smith,

 Smith Engineering Company)
 - This item, previously Item 10BIII, was presented out of order.
 - Mr. Rubio stated that the 60% set of plans were in the agenda and that an on-site meeting with Mr. Selchan, Mr. Steve Smith and Mr. Larry Smith was conducted prior to this meeting to discuss any issues before going onto the next phase of the project.
- 48 Mr. Larry Smith, of Smith Engineering Consultants, Inc. (SEC), reported the following:
- PS1 and PS2 Electrical Upgrades: The PS2 pump would increase from 200 to 250 horsepower (hp), as most of the electrical equipment was being replaced. The PS1 pump would increase from 100 to 150 hp, which is believed adequate to handle the load of the two pumps.
- 52 The goal was to submit the 90% plan next month and the 100% plan in April.
 - Mr. McKune conveyed, and Mr. Selchan agreed, that Mr. Larry Smith was doing a great job. Mr. Ortiz perceived, from the meeting he participated in a few weeks ago, that everything was moving in the right direction and SEC could get to 90% within one month.
- The following were in response to questions about the project:
 - Type of Starters: SEC would proceed with the original recommendation to use the same technology, as most of Mr. Selchan's issues were with the breakers in the starters and not the starters themselves. That decision was made during the on-site inspection today; this would be a cost savings on the project. Salvaging components in PS 1 was determined to not be in the best interest of the District. The items to be replaced were discussed.
 - Florida Power & Light (FPL): FPL would disconnect the power to the transformer while the new cables are installed. FPL would also do the final tie in to the transformer and reconnect the pump station. Backup equipment would be on site, if needed.
 - The project should be completed within the next month or so. Backup equipment would be available during this time.
- Mr. Selchan preferred starting with PS2 and to have the equipment for PS1 ready to proceed, once PS2 is completed and fully operational.

Mr. Steve Smith discussed the tentative summary schedule comprised of various projects and dates, which was distributed during the meeting. A more detailed backup to the schedule would be provided. He suggested coordinating the PS2 project with the West Outfall Canal – Phase 2B project, simultaneously, so the area is only shut down once. He recommended the preparing an appropriate Request for Qualifications (RFQs) and Request for Proposals (RFPs) and that Radise International prepare the design build package, cost proposals and timelines of each project for presentation and approval next month, with the expectation to commence work as early as December 1, 2021. He expected that everything could be operational before the 2022 wet season.

Discussion ensued regarding the design build, proceeding with Dr. Werth's recommendations and coordinating with him. Mr. McKune agreed with this approach, as long as he, Mr. Selchan and Mr. Craig A. Smith are involved in the document preparation sessions. Staff agreed with these recommendations.

Presentation: Monthly Engineer's Report

This item, previously Item 10BI, was presented out of order

Mr. Rubio presented the Monthly Report and gave an update on the Electrical Engineering Services for PS1 and PS2 items discussed in the virtual meeting and the follow-up field visit to both stations. He discussed the upcoming ROW permit applications recommended for approval.

Mr. Morera asked about the vendor who pierced a District culvert. Mr. Rubio stated he was working with the vendor to address their obligations. Discussion ensued regarding the timeline to complete the repairs, the slow response, District Counsel issuing a letter to address the response time, etc. Mr. Rubio was directed to discuss the status of the repairs with the vendor and provide information to District Counsel, if he was not satisfied with the answer. District Counsel was directed to send the letter with a seven-day deadline to comply. An update on this matter would be added to the next agenda, under the District Engineer Status Report.

Craig A. Smith & Associates, Inc. (CAS) is pleased to provide you with the MER summarizing activity performed by this office on behalf of SWCD during the referenced period including future work. Anything of significance or modifications occurring after this writing will be brought up at the March 10, 2021 BOS meeting.

Electrical Engineering Services for Pump Station 1 and Pump Station 2

Plans are under development for the 90% submittal phase.


West Outfall Canal Phase 2B

For BOS consideration, the following proposals are submitted as discussed in the previous BOS meeting.

• Riverside Dr. Bridge (RDB) and Pump Station 2 (PS2) intake bay improvements: Proposal to authorize Radise International (RI) to develop a design-build criteria bid package for the design and construction of the Lag Board Shoring options previously presented to the board for RDB and for the design and construction modification of the concrete intake bay at PS2.

We recall that the concrete intake bay is sloped from elevation at 0' ft-NGVD to (-) 4 ft-NGVD and it is the intent to flatten this sloped section to elevation (-) 4.0 ft-NGVD including the upstream canal segment as proposed by CAS (see Figure 1).

In coordination with CAS, RI will assist SWCD team members in the development of the bid advertisement, conduct a MS Teams pre-bid meeting, respond to design-builder requests for additional information, review, and recommendation of the design-build submittals through CAS (see attached proposal).

- WOFC Phase 2B improvements: Proposal to authorize CAS to develop engineering plans for the canal improvements from PS2 to 100+ yards north of Riverside Dr (see attached proposal). This proposal goes hand-in-hand with the aforementioned design-build task as well as the other proposal from RI for the soil sampling analysis (below).
- WOFC Phase 2B improvements Sediment Analysis: In order to obtain the chemical quality of the soils and condition of the subsurface materials to be excavated, attached is a proposal from Radise International to perform sampling/borings along this stretch of the canal, similarly to the previous canal Phase 1B and Canal Z. Soil chemical quality information is also desired to characterize sediments that currently mantle the canal bottom since that will affect how the materials can be reused and/or disposed of.

Right-of-Way (ROW) Permitting

Crown Castle (fka Fibernet Direct) - Original SWCD Permit No. 2018-02. This permit authorized the fiber optic installations at multiple SWCD locations having two sets of plans identified as the Northfeed and the Southfeed and the plans were originally developed by Southern Engineering. From the original permit, CAS received asbuilt plans for the installation and determined 8 non-compliant installations where it was later determined that pipe damages were discovered at one of these locations. This entailed multiple communication efforts with the permittee, a pipe inspection by Industrial Divers, CAS utility locating personnel, and a legal correspondence to initiate a resolution to these matters.

Crown Castle hired DraftPros to develop plans to reflect the proposed mitigation of the non-compliant items. In all, seven (7) <u>individual</u> applications were submitted. The submittals from DraftPros were identified differently than how Southern Engineering prepared their submittal which caused some confusion with CAS & WHA staff but we were eventually able to cross reference each accordingly to perform the reviews. One installation, after field verification with CAS locates staff, was determined to be in compliance (North feed P-8) and no further action will be required with this installation. Reviews of each of the new applications were conducted, cost recovery fees were requested, and comments requesting revisions were addressed by DraftPros. Regarding the damage pipes, Crown Castle will be utilizing the services of Industrial Divers to perform the pipe repair (North feed P-12 – 12409NW39ST). Cost recovery fees (\$21,185.50) were submitted on 2.25.2021 to the District Manager's office to cover past engineering review and legal fees plus the projected review efforts.

The applicant is awaiting permit reviews from Broward County and the City of Coral Springs. Once these are approved a timeline of the proposed work will be submitted.

We have reviewed a R/W permit application submitted by Crown Castle Fiber for directional bore of 268 LF 4-1.25" HDPE conduits along the canal bank beneath the culvert and culvert repairs. The applicant is required to provide culvert repairs as it was found during a field investigation by Industrial Divers Corporation, that there is penetration and damage to the existing culvert. This appears to be resulting from the previous boring performed from their conduit installation. The proposed work will be located on the north right-of-way of NW 39th St. crossing the canal. The applicant has met SWCD applicable criteria and we recommend that the SWCD Board of Supervisors issue a Right-of-Way Permit to the applicant, subject to the following Special Conditions to be made part of the Permit:

- 1. This application was submitted to address a non-compliant installation at this location and the resubmittal proposes to remedy the installation by installing a new utility and remove the non-compliant utility.
- 2. The proposed pipe repair is hereby reference under this condition and is attached to the permit as Exhibit "A".



After conduits are removed the holes will be packed with hydraulic cement. RADISE International, LC (RADISE) is pleased to submit this proposal to provide geotechnical engineering services for the above referenced project located in Broward County, Florida. This proposal presents our proposed scope of work and establishes our fee for performing the work.

Sunshine Water Control District (SWCD) requires the services of a Design Consultant to support the proposed widening of the canal beneath the Riverside Drive Bridge as well as modification of the concrete intake bay at Pump Station 2 (PS2). This procured is being procured using the Design-Build approach. RADISE will develop a design-build criteria bid package for the design and construction of the Lag Board Shoring (LBS & PCI) improvement options for the Riverside Drive Bridge. This work will generally include:

- Preparation of upfront D/B contracting and Scope of Work criteria documents;

- Coordination with CAS regarding Pump Station intake bay demolition areas and existing drawings to be included in the D/B package;

- Assistance to CAS in compiling and issuing the D/B -Request For a Proposal (RFP) Package;
- RADISE will also assist CAS in conducting a pre-bid meeting and responses to design-builder requests for additional information;
- Evaluation of received RFP Package Responses and recommendations for selection of a D/B Team/Contractor:

Public involvement meetings, utility coordination, and Local County or Municipality environmental and other permit coordinations/submittals, are not included in the scope of work identified above.

Based upon our understanding of the project and interpretation of your requirements, we propose to perform the proposed scope of work for a Lump Sum Fee as detailed in the Fee Breakdown on Attachment A. Our work will be performed in accordance with the General Terms and Conditions included as part of this proposal as Attachment B.

ATTACHMENT B - AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL GEOTECHNICAL SERVICES STANDARD GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This Agreement between **Craig A. Smith & Associates ("CLIENT")** and **RADISE International LC ("RADISE")**, a Florida Limited International; 4152 West Blue Heron Blvd., Suite 1114 Riviera Beach, FL 33404 is effective as of the date of signature of the acceptance block of this written proposal. The ordering of Work from RADISE shall constitute acceptance of the terms of RADISE's proposal and these General Conditions. The parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE I — PARTIES AND SCOPE OF WORK - RADISE shall include said company, its individual owners, officers, professionals, employees, agents, division, subsidiary, parent or affiliate and subcontractors performing the Work. "Work" means the specific services to be performed by RADISE as set forth in RADISE's proposal, the CLIENT's acceptance thereof, both incorporated herein by this reference, and these General Conditions. "CLIENT" refers to the person and/or business entity ordering the Work to be done by RADISE. If the CLIENT is ordering the Work on behalf of a third party, the CLIENT represents and warrants that the CLIENT is the duly authorized agent of said third party for the purpose of ordering and directing said Work. In the event CLIENT is not the authorized agent of said third party, CLIENT agrees that he shall be individually liable hereunder. Further, CLIENT shall disclose any such agency relationship to RADISE in writing before the commencement of RADISE's Work hereunder. CLIENT agrees that RADISE's professional duties are specifically limited to the Work as set forth in RADISE's proposal. The CLIENT assumes sole responsibility for determining whether the quantity and the nature of the Work ordered by the CLIENT is adequate and sufficient for the CLIENT's intended purpose. CLIENT shall communicate these General Terms and Conditions to each and every third party to whom the CLIENT transmits any part of RADISE's Work. RADISE's Work is for the exclusive use of CLIENT, and its properly disclosed principal. In no event shall RADISE have any duty or obligation to any third party. No third party shall have the right to rely on RADISE opinions rendered in connection with the Services without RADISE written consent and the third party's agreement to be bound to the same conditions and limitations as CLIENT. In the event that RADISE is not a party, CLIENT or is required by subpoena to produce documents or give testimony in any action or proceeding to which CLIENT is a party and RADISE is

ARTICLE II – PAYMENT - Payment shall be due within 30 days after the date of invoice. Interest at the rate of 1.5% per month (or the highest rate allowable by law) starting 30 days after date of invoice to date payment is received, may be added to all amounts not paid within 30 days after date of invoice. If payment is not maintained on a thirty (30) day current basis, RADISE shall have the contractual right to suspend further performance of the work until payments are made current. CLIENT shall notify RADISE of any disputed amount within fifteen (15) days from date of the invoice, give reasons for the objection, and shall promptly pay the undisputed amount. All attorney fees and expenses associated with collection of past due invoices will be paid by CLIENT. Failure to timely pay any RADISE invoice shall constitute a waiver of any and all claims by CLIENT or third parties against RADISE.

ARTICLE III — RIGHT-OF-ENTRY - Unless otherwise agreed, CLIENT shall furnish right-of-entry on the property for RADISE to perform the requested testing and/or make the planned borings, surveys, or explorations. RADISE will take reasonable precautions to minimize damage to the property or man-made objects caused by its equipment and sampling procedures, but the cost of restoration or damage repair which may result from the planned and contracted operations, is not included in the contracted amount unless specifically identified and detailed. If the CLIENT desires and requests in writing to restore the property or man-made objects to its former condition. RADISE can accomplish this at an added cost to our fee as approved in advance by the CLIENT.

ARTICLE IV – DAMAGE TO EXISTING MAN-MADE OBJECTS - It shall be the responsibility of the CLIENT or his duly authorized representative, to disclose the presence and accurate location of all hidden or obscure man-made objects relative to field tests, sampling, or boring locations. RADISE will clear field test boring locations with Florida Sunshine One-Call as required by Florida Statues, as a supplemental disclosure process above that required of the CLIENT. In addition, CLIENT waives any claim against RADISE arising from any damage to land surfaces or existing buried or surficial man-made objects. CLIENT shall: (1) provide RADISE, in writing, all information relating to CLIENT's requirements for the project; (2) correctly identify to RADISE, the location of subsurface structures, such as pipes, tanks, cables and utilities; (3) notify RADISE of any potential hazardous substances or other health and safety hazard or condition known to CLIENT existing on or near the project site; (4) give RADISE prompt written notice of any suspected deficiency in the Services; and (5) with reasonable promptness, provide required approvals and decisions.

ARTICLE V – SAMPLING OR TESTING LOCATIONS - Unless specifically stated to the contrary, the fees included in this proposal do not include costs associated with professional land surveying of the site or the accurate horizontal and vertical locations of tests or for the repair of land damage occurring during the performance of the contracted work. Field tests or boring locations, as described in our report or shown on our sketches, are based on specific information furnished to us by others or estimates of locations made in the field by our inspectors or technicians. Such dimensions, depths or elevations should be considered as approximations unless otherwise stated in the report.

ARTICLE VI – SAMPLE HANDLING AND RETENTION - Generally test samples or specimens are consumed and/or substantially altered during the conduct of tests and RADISE, at its sole discretion, will dispose (subject to the following) of any remaining residue immediately upon completion of test unless required in writing by the CLIENT to store or otherwise handle the samples. (a) NON-HAZARDOUS SAMPLES: At CLIENT's written request, RADISE will maintain free of storage charges, procured test samples and specimens or the residue therefrom, for thirty (30) days after the submission of RADISE's report to CLIENT. After the initial 30 days and upon written request, RADISE will retain test specimens or samples for a mutually acceptable storage charge and period of time. (b) HAZARDOUS OR POTENTIALLY HAZARDOUS SAMPLES: In the event that samples contain substances or constituents hazardous or detrimental to human health, safety or the environment, as defined by federal, state or local statutes, regulations, or ordinances ("Hazardous Substances" and "Hazardous Constituents", respectively), RADISE will, after completion of testing and at CLIENT's expense: (i) return such samples to CLIENT; (i) using a manifest signed by CLIENT as generator, will have such samples transported to a location selected by CLIENT for final disposal. CLIENT agrees to pay all costs associated with the storage, transport, and disposal of such samples. CLIENT recognizes and agrees that RADISE is acting as a bailee for Client and at no time does RADISE assume title or ownership of said waste.

ARTICLE VII – DISCOVERY OF UNANTICIPATED HAZARDOUS MATERIALS - Hazardous materials or certain types of hazardous materials may exist at a site where there is no reason to believe they could or should be present. RADISE and CLIENT agree that the discovery of unanticipated hazardous materials constitutes a changed condition mandating a renegotiation of the scope of work or termination of services. RADISE and CLIENT also agree that the discovery of unanticipated hazardous materials may make it necessary for RADISE to take immediate measures to protect health and safety. RADISE

agrees to notify CLIENT as soon as practicable should unanticipated hazardous materials or suspected hazardous materials be encountered. CLIENT encourages RADISE to take any and all measures that, in RADISE's professional opinion, are justified to preserve and protect the health and safety of RADISE's personnel and the public. CLIENT agrees to compensate RADISE for the additional cost of working to protect employees' and the public's health and safety. In addition, CLIENT waives any claim against RADISE arising from RADISE's discovery of unanticipated hazardous materials or suspected hazardous materials.

ARTICLE VIII – STATEMENT OF WARRANTY - RADISE warrants that it shall perform services for CLIENT in a professional manner, using that degree of care and skill ordinarily exercised by and consistent with the applicable standards of professional care that are being practiced in the profession and in the same or a similar locality as the project. CLIENT recognizes that opinions relating to environmental, geologic, and geotechnical conditions are based on limited site information and data obtained by literature reviews and/or the performance of limited site investigational programs and that actual conditions may vary from those encountered at the times and locations where the data are obtained, despite the use of due professional care. In the event any portion of the services fails to comply with this warranty obligation and RADISE is promptly notified in writing within six (6) months after completion of such portion of the services, RADISE shall be provided the opportunity re- perform and correct such portion of the services, or if re-performance is impracticable, RADISE shall refund the appropriate proportional amount of compensation paid to RADISE for such deficient portion of the services. This warranty is in lieu of any and all other warranties. No other warranty, expressed or implied, including warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose, is made or intended by the proposal for consulting services, by furnishing an oral response of the findings made or by any representations made regarding the services included in this agreement.

ARTICLE IX – LIMITATION OF LIABILITY - RADISE shall be responsible and liable to CLIENT for RADISE services and the services of RADISE subcontractors engaged in the performance of the work. RADISE shall not be responsible or liable for the acts or omissions of the CLIENT or other parties engaged by CLIENT for their services including but not limited to other engineering reports and data, construction means, methods, techniques, sequences, or procedures, or their health and safety precautions and programs. In no event shall RADISE be liable for any special, indirect, incidental or consequential loss or delay or time-related damages. Neither Party shall be liable to the other for consequential damages, including, without limitation, loss of use or loss of profits, incurred by one another or their subsidiaries or successors or assigns, regardless of whether such damages are caused by breach of contract, willful misconduct, negligent act or omission, or other wrongful act of either of them.

Client is also advised that Florida Statutes (FS), Section 558.0035 - Design professionals; contractual limitation on liability states that 1) A design professional employed by a business entity or an agent of the business entity is not individually liable for damages resulting from negligence occurring within the course and scope of a professional services contract if certain conditions apply. Correspondingly: PURSUANT TO THIS FS SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL EMPLOYEE OR AGENT OF RADISE MAY NOT BE HELD INDIVIDUALLY LIABLE FOR NEGLIGENCE. This release of individual liability applies only so long as any damages are solely economic in nature and the damages do not extend to personal injuries or to property not subject to the contract.

The remedies set forth herein are exclusive and the total liability of RADISE for all claims arising out of the performance of the Work including sole professional negligence including errors, omissions, or other professional acts, and including unintentional breach of contract; or for other causes for which RADISE is determined to have any legal liability in a court of law. Remedies, whether in contract, tort (including negligence whether sole or concurrent), or otherwise arising out of, connected with or resulting from the services provided by RADISE pursuant to this Agreement, shall not exceed the total fees paid to RADISE by CLIENT or \$50,000.00, whichever is lessor. CLIENT may, upon written request received within five days of CLIENT's acceptance hereof, increase the limit of RADISE's liability by agreeing to pay RADISE an additional sum as agreed to in writing prior to the commencement of RADISE's services. This charge is not to be construed as being a charge for insurance of any type, but is increased consideration for the greater liability involved.

ARTICLE X – CLIENT INDEMNIFICATION - CLIENT agrees to defend, indemnify and save harmless RADISE from all third party and any FS 558 claims unrelated to our work activities and designs, including but not limited to alleged negligence claims, suits, losses, personal injuries, death and property liability not directly resulting or related to RADISE's performance of the proposed work, whether such claims or damages are allegedly caused in whole or in part by RADISE. CLIENT agrees to reimburse RADISE for expenses in connection with any such claims or suits, including reasonable attorney's fees. CLIENT's obligation to indemnify is limited to \$2 million per occurrence, which CLIENT agrees bears a reasonable commercial relationship to the Work undertaken by RADISE. CLIENT further agrees that these General Terms and Conditions are a part of the Work's specifications or bid documents, if any.

ARTICLE XI – LEGAL JURISDICTION - The parties agree that any actions brought to enforce any provision of this Agreement shall only be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction located in West Palm Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida. All causes of action, including but not limited to actions for indemnification, arising out of RADISE's Work shall be deemed to have accrued and the applicable statutes of limitation shall commence to run not later than either the date of substantial completion of the Work for acts or failures to act occurring prior to substantial completion, or the date of issuance of RADISE's final invoice for acts or failures to act occurring after substantial completion of the Work.

ARTICLE XII – FORCE MAJEURE - An event of "Force Majeure · occurs when an event beyond the control of the Party claiming Force Majeure prevents such Party from fulfilling its obligations. An event of Force Majeure includes, without limitation, acts of God (including floods, hurricanes and other adverse weather), war, riot. civil disorder, acts of terrorism, disease, epidemic, strikes and labor disputes, actions or inactions of government or other authorities, law enforcement actions, curfews, closure of transportation systems or other unusual travel difficulties, or inability to provide a safe working environment for employees. In the event of Force Majeure, the obligations of RADISE to perform the Services shall be suspended for the duration of the event of Force Majeure. In such event, RADISE shall be equitably compensated for time expended and expenses incurred during the event of Force Majeure and the schedule shall be extended by a like number of days as the event of Force Majeure. If Services are suspended for thirty (30) days or more, RADISE may, in its sole discretion and upon 10 days' prior written notice, terminate this Agreement or the affected Wor1<, or both. RADISE shall be compensated for those services performed as of the date of the termination.

ARTICLE XIII – TERMINATION - CLIENT or RADISE may terminate this agreement with or without cause at any time by giving ten (10) days' notice to either party. CLIENT may terminate this agreement for cause by giving ten (10) days' notice to RADISE. Cause is defined as nonpayment of RADISE's invoices and/or unresponsiveness by RADISE to CLIENT's requests. If this agreement is terminated by either party, RADISE shall be compensated for work actually performed and expense incurred up to the date of termination, but in no event more than the amounts set forth in RADISE's proposal for the work. This agreement will terminate automatically upon termination of any Prime Contract related to and associated with the work

For Board of Supervisors consideration, Craig A. Smith and Associates (CAS) is pleased to provide a professional services proposal to continue to improve the hydraulic capacity of the West Outfall Canal by widening and deepening the canal from the Pump Station 2 to approximately 100 yards north of Riverside Drive Bridge (location map provided at the end of this document). Through hydraulic analysis it has been estimated that the hydraulic performance of the canal as controlled by PS2 can be enhanced by widening and deepening the canal. Please note that the CAS proposed work will strictly entail the canal improvements but will also reflect structural improvements at Riverside Drive Bridge and the concrete intake bay modification at PS2 which are to be designed by others in order to submit a complete permit submittal to the appropriate agencies. Construction of these structural improvements are to be performed as part of and go hand-in-hand with the Phase 2B canal improvements. These structural improvements, when authorized, will be performed under a design-build contract by others.

Survey data obtained from CAS Project No. 17-1961 will be used for the development of the CAS engineering plans. These were the plans used for the encroachment removal phase.

The proposed services include the following tasks:





Proposal for Geotechnical Engineering Services Sunshine Water Control District West Outfall Canal Improvements – Phase 2B Broward County, Florida

Dear Mr. Rubio,

RADISE International, LC (RADISE) is pleased to submit this proposal to provide geotechnical engineering services for the above referenced project located in Broward County, Florida. It is our understanding that is proposed to widen the West Outfall Canal between Riverside Drive and the pump station structure south of Riverside Drive. Two (2) Standard Penetration Test (SPT) borings were performed by RADISE near the Riverside Drive bridge during a previous geotechnical investigation. RADISE will use that information along with the additional explorations proposed herein to obtain general subsurface soil information to support project design. This proposal presents our proposed scope of work and establishes our schedule and fee for performing the work.

SCOPE OF WORK

The proposed scope of work for the project consists of the following:

- 1. Visit the project site to observe and photograph existing site conditions and to field mark planned boring and test locations.
- 2. Contact Sunshine 811 to request the field location of underground utilities in the area of the borings as per Florida Statutes, and coordinate the clearance of underground utilities at the boring locations for performance of the field activities.
- 3. Mobilize a truck-mounted drill rig and crew.
- 4. Perform two (2) Standard Penetration Test (SPT) soil borings (ASTM D-1586) each to a depth of 20 feet below the existing ground surface between Riverside Drive and the pump station structure. Following completion of the drilling and testing, the boreholes will be backfilled with grout.
- 5. Collect two (2) sediment samples from the bottom of the canal.

- 6. Visual Classification of soil samples in accordance with the Unified Soil Classification System (USCS).
- 7. Laboratory testing of selected soil samples for index properties limited to moisture content, full sieve analysis, fines content, Atterberg limits, organic content, and corrosion tests.
- 8. The sediment samples will be analyzed by NELAP approved laboratory for polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbons (PAH), total recoverable petroleum hydrocarbons (TRPH) and for the metals chromium, copper, arsenic, mercury and lead.
- 9. Prepare one (1) Geotechnical Data Report providing the results of the SPT borings, the soil and sediment laboratory testing results, and the characteristics and properties of the soils.

SCHEDULE/DELIVERABLES

Upon receiving written authorization to proceed, we will commence with field marking of the boring locations and preparation of the utility locate request ticket. Mobilization for the drilling operations will occur soon after Sunshine 811 clearance of boring locations is received from the contacted utilities. These upfront activities are expected to require about 2 to 3 weeks to complete.

The specified field drilling work is expected to require 1 day to complete. Laboratory visual classification of the soils and report preparation will require about 2 weeks to complete following completion of field work. We expect to provide the final report signed and sealed by a registered professional engineer within 5 weeks of notice to proceed.

COMPENSATION & TERMS

Based upon our understanding of the project and interpretation of your requirements, we propose to perform the proposed scope of work for a Lump Sum Fee as detailed in the Fee Breakdown on Attachment A. Our work will be performed in accordance with the General Terms and Conditions included as part of this proposal as Attachment B.

Soil samples obtained from the drilling operations will be retained by RADISE for a period of 90 days from the date of drilling and then they will be discarded unless alternate terms are agreed to in writing with the client.

ATTACHMENT B - AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL GEOTECHNICAL SERVICES STANDARD GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This Agreement between **Craig A. Smith & Associates ("CLIENT")** and **RADISE International LC ("RADISE")**, a Florida Limited International; 4152 West Blue Heron Blvd., Suite 1114 Riviera Beach, FL 33404 is effective as of the date of signature of the acceptance block of this written proposal. The ordering of Work from RADISE shall constitute acceptance of the terms of RADISE's proposal and these General Conditions. The parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE I — PARTIES AND SCOPE OF WORK - RADISE shall include said company, its individual owners, officers, professionals, employees, agents, division, subsidiary, parent or affiliate and subcontractors performing the Work. "Work" means the specific services to be performed by RADISE as set forth in RADISE's proposal, the CLIENT's acceptance thereof, both incorporated herein by this reference, and these General Conditions. "CLIENT" refers to the person and/or business entity ordering the Work to be done by RADISE. If the CLIENT is ordering the Work on behalf of a third party, the CLIENT represents and warrants that the CLIENT is the duly authorized agent of said third party for the purpose of ordering and directing said Work. In the event CLIENT is not the authorized agent of said third party, CLIENT agrees that he shall be individually liable hereunder. Further, CLIENT shall disclose any such agency relationship to RADISE in writing before the commencement of RADISE's Work hereunder. CLIENT agrees that RADISE's professional duties are specifically limited to the Work as set forth in RADISE's proposal. The CLIENT assumes sole responsibility for determining whether the quantity and the nature of the Work ordered by the CLIENT is adequate and sufficient for the CLIENT's intended purpose. CLIENT shall communicate these General Terms and Conditions to each and every third party to whom the CLIENT transmits any part of RADISE's Work. RADISE's Work is for the exclusive use of CLIENT, and its properly disclosed principal. In no event shall RADISE have any duty or obligation to any third party. No third party shall have the right to rely on RADISE opinions rendered in connection with the Services without RADISE written consent and the third party's agreement to be bound to the same conditions and limitations as CLIENT. In the event that RADISE is not a party, CLIENT or is required by subpoena to produce documents or give testimony in any action or proceeding to which CLIENT is a party and RADISE is

ARTICLE II – PAYMENT - Payment shall be due within 30 days after the date of invoice. Interest at the rate of 1.5% per month (or the highest rate allowable by law) starting 30 days after date of invoice to date payment is received, may be added to all amounts not paid within 30 days after date of invoice. If payment is not maintained on a thirty (30) day current basis, RADISE shall have the contractual right to suspend further performance of the work until payments are made current. CLIENT shall notify RADISE of any disputed amount within fifteen (15) days from date of the invoice, give reasons for the objection, and shall promptly pay the undisputed amount. All attorney fees and expenses associated with collection of past due invoices will be paid by CLIENT. Failure to timely pay any RADISE invoice shall constitute a waiver of any and all claims by CLIENT or third parties against RADISE.

ARTICLE III — RIGHT-OF-ENTRY - Unless otherwise agreed, CLIENT shall furnish right-of-entry on the property for RADISE to perform the requested testing and/or make the planned borings, surveys, or explorations. RADISE will take reasonable precautions to minimize damage to the property or man-made objects caused by its equipment and sampling procedures, but the cost of restoration or damage repair which may result from the planned and contracted operations, is not included in the contracted amount unless specifically identified and detailed. If the CLIENT desires and requests in writing to restore the property or man-made objects to its former condition. RADISE can accomplish this at an added cost to our fee as approved in advance by the CLIENT.

ARTICLE IV – DAMAGE TO EXISTING MAN-MADE OBJECTS - It shall be the responsibility of the CLIENT or his duly authorized representative, to disclose the presence and accurate location of all hidden or obscure man-made objects relative to field tests, sampling, or boring locations. RADISE will clear field test boring locations with Florida Sunshine One-Call as required by Florida Statues, as a supplemental disclosure process above that required of the CLIENT. In addition, CLIENT waives any claim against RADISE arising from any damage to land surfaces or existing buried or surficial man-made objects. CLIENT shall: (1) provide RADISE, in writing, all information relating to CLIENT's requirements for the project; (2) correctly identify to RADISE, the location of subsurface structures, such as pipes, tanks, cables and utilities; (3) notify RADISE of any potential hazardous substances or other health and safety hazard or condition known to CLIENT existing on or near the project site; (4) give RADISE prompt written notice of any suspected deficiency in the Services; and (5) with reasonable promptness, provide required approvals and decisions.

ARTICLE V – SAMPLING OR TESTING LOCATIONS - Unless specifically stated to the contrary, the fees included in this proposal do not include costs associated with professional land surveying of the site or the accurate horizontal and vertical locations of tests or for the repair of land damage occurring during the performance of the contracted work. Field tests or boring locations, as described in our report or shown on our sketches, are based on specific information furnished to us by others or estimates of locations made in the field by our inspectors or technicians. Such dimensions, depths or elevations should be considered as approximations unless otherwise stated in the report.

ARTICLE VI – SAMPLE HANDLING AND RETENTION - Generally test samples or specimens are consumed and/or substantially altered during the conduct of tests and RADISE, at its sole discretion, will dispose (subject to the following) of any remaining residue immediately upon completion of test unless required in writing by the CLIENT to store or otherwise handle the samples. (a) NON-HAZARDOUS SAMPLES: At CLIENT's written request, RADISE will maintain free of storage charges, procured test samples and specimens or the residue therefrom, for thirty (30) days after the submission of RADISE's report to CLIENT. After the initial 30 days and upon written request, RADISE will retain test specimens or samples for a mutually acceptable storage charge and period of time. (b) HAZARDOUS OR POTENTIALLY HAZARDOUS SAMPLES: In the event that samples contain substances or constituents hazardous or detrimental to human health, safety or the environment, as defined by federal, state or local statutes, regulations, or ordinances ("Hazardous Substances" and "Hazardous Constituents", respectively), RADISE will, after completion of testing and at CLIENT's expense: (i) return such samples to CLIENT; (i) using a manifest signed by CLIENT as generator, will have such samples transported to a location selected by CLIENT for final disposal. CLIENT agrees to pay all costs associated with the storage, transport, and disposal of such samples. CLIENT recognizes and agrees that RADISE is acting as a bailee for Client and at no time does RADISE assume title or ownership of said waste.

ARTICLE VII – DISCOVERY OF UNANTICIPATED HAZARDOUS MATERIALS - Hazardous materials or certain types of hazardous materials may exist at a site where there is no reason to believe they could or should be present. RADISE and CLIENT agree that the discovery of unanticipated hazardous materials constitutes a changed condition mandating a renegotiation of the scope of work or termination of services. RADISE and CLIENT also agree that the discovery of unanticipated hazardous materials may make it necessary for RADISE to take immediate measures to protect health and safety. RADISE

CLIENT agrees to compensate RADISE for the additional cost of working to protect employees' and the public's health and safety. In addition, CLIENT waives any claim against RADISE arising from RADISE's discovery of unanticipated hazardous materials or suspected hazardous materials.

CLIENT recognizes that opinions relating to environmental, geologic, and geotechnical conditions are based on limited site information and data obtained by literature reviews and/or the performance of limited site investigational programs and that actual conditions may vary from those encountered at the times and locations where the data are obtained, despite the use of due professional care. In the event any portion of the services fails to comply with this warranty obligation and RADISE is promptly notified in writing within six (6) months after completion of such portion of the services, RADISE shall be provided the opportunity re- perform and correct such portion of the services, or if re-performance is impracticable, RADISE shall refund the appropriate proportional amount of compensation paid to RADISE for such deficient portion of the services. This warranty is in lieu of any and all other warranties. No other warranty, expressed or implied, including warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose, is made or intended by the proposal for consulting services, by furnishing an oral response of the findings made or by any representations made regarding the services included in this agreement.

ARTICLE IX – LIMITATION OF LIABILITY - RADISE shall be responsible and liable to CLIENT for RADISE services and the services of RADISE subcontractors engaged in the performance of the work. RADISE shall not be responsible or liable for the acts or omissions of the CLIENT or other parties engaged by CLIENT for their services including but not limited to other engineering reports and data, construction means, methods, techniques, sequences, or procedures, or their health and safety precautions and programs. In no event shall RADISE be liable for any special, indirect, incidental or consequential loss or delay or time-related damages. This release of individual liability applies only so long as any damages are solely economic in nature and the damages do not extend to personal injuries or to property not subject to the contract.

The remedies set forth herein are exclusive and the total liability of RADISE for all claims arising out of the performance of the Work including sole professional negligence including errors, omissions, or other professional acts, and including unintentional breach of contract; or for other causes for which RADISE is determined to have any legal liability in a court of law. Remedies, whether in contract, tort (including negligence whether sole or concurrent), or otherwise arising out of, connected with or resulting from the services provided by RADISE pursuant to this Agreement, shall not exceed the total fees paid to RADISE by CLIENT or \$50,000.00, whichever is lessor. CLIENT may, upon written request received within five days of CLIENT's acceptance hereof, increase the limit of RADISE's liability by agreeing to pay RADISE an additional sum as agreed to in writing prior to the commencement of RADISE's services. This charge is not to be construed as being a charge for insurance of any type, but is increased consideration for the greater liability involved.

ARTICLE X – CLIENT INDEMNIFICATION - CLIENT agrees to defend, indemnify and save harmless RADISE from all third party and any FS 558 claims unrelated to our work activities and designs, including but not limited to alleged negligence claims, suits, losses, personal injuries, death and property liability not directly resulting or related to RADISE's performance of the proposed work, whether such claims or damages are allegedly caused in whole or in part by RADISE. CLIENT agrees to reimburse RADISE for expenses in connection with any such claims or suits, including reasonable attorney's fees. CLIENT's obligation to indemnify is limited to \$2 million per occurrence, which CLIENT agrees bears a reasonable commercial relationship to the Work undertaken by RADISE. CLIENT further agrees that these General Terms and Conditions are a part of the Work's specifications or bid documents, if any.

All causes of action, including but not limited to actions for indemnification, arising out of RADISE's Work shall be deemed to have accrued and the applicable statutes of limitation shall commence to run not later than either the date of substantial completion of the Work for acts or failures to act occurring prior to substantial completion, or the date of issuance of RADISE's final invoice for acts or failures to act occurring after substantial completion of the Work.

ARTICLE XII – FORCE MAJEURE - An event of "Force Majeure · occurs when an event beyond the control of the Party claiming Force Majeure prevents such Party from fulfilling its obligations. An event of Force Majeure includes, without limitation, acts of God (including floods, hurricanes and other adverse weather), war, riot. civil disorder, acts of terrorism, disease, epidemic, strikes and labor disputes, actions or inactions of government or other authorities, law enforcement actions, curfews, closure of transportation systems or other unusual travel difficulties, or inability to provide a safe working environment for employees. In the event of Force Majeure, the obligations of RADISE to perform the Services shall be suspended for the duration of the event of Force Majeure. In such event, RADISE shall be equitably compensated for time expended and expenses incurred during the event of Force Majeure and the schedule shall be extended by a like number of days as the event of Force Majeure. If Services are suspended for thirty (30) days or more, RADISE may, in its sole discretion and upon 10 days' prior written notice, terminate this Agreement or the affected Wor1<, or both. RADISE shall be compensated for those services performed as of the date of the termination.

WHEREAS, Owner holds title to a certain parcel of real estate more particularly described as:

(hereinafter referred to as the "Property"), and

WHEREAS, the Property is encumbered by a certain right-of-way/easement (hereinafter referred to as the "ROW/Easement"), such Easement being for the benefit of the District and its drainage system, and

WHEREAS, the ROW/Easement has been obstructed by the unauthorized growth of vegetation and/or construction of structures within said ROW/Easement; and

WHEREAS, Owner, pursuant to Option 2 of the District's Right-of-Way/Easement Clearing Policy, elects to have the District remove said obstructions at the District's expense,

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the covenants set forth herein, Owner hereby agrees as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. The District will remove all obstructions located in the ROW/Easement at the District's expense subject to the terms herein. For purposes of this Agreement, "obstructions" shall be defined as all vegetation and all structures located on District property that prevent required maintenance and present a threat to human life, property, public health and safety, as depicted on Attachment A hereto. The District shall have sole discretion to determine what constitutes an obstruction pursuant to this Agreement.

- 3. The District's obligations pursuant to this Agreement are limited to a single, one-time-only removal of obstructions existing within the ROW/Easement at the time of this Agreement. The District shall not be obligated to remove, at its expense, obstructions placed within the ROW/Easement by Owner subsequent to the execution of this Agreement.
- 4. Subsequent to District's removal of existing obstructions from the ROW/Easement, Owner shall be required to maintain and mow the grassy areas within the ROW/Easement that remain adjacent to his/her property and keep the same free from all structures and growth of vegetation which may become obstructions of the ROW/Easement. Failure of Owner to comply with this requirement shall constitute a material breach of this Agreement and Owner shall be liable to the District for all costs associated with District's having to remove any subsequent obstructions or perform required maintenance.
- 5. If the District notifies Owner that he/she is in material breach of this Agreement and Owner fails to remedy the identified breach by removing the obstruction or performing the required maintenance within 30 days of receipt of notice, the District shall take all necessary steps to resolve the obstruction and Owner shall be invoiced and/or assessed on the Broward County tax roll the cost for the removal of all obstructions and/or performance of required maintenance, as well as any related administrative or legal fees that may be incurred by the District.
- 6. This Agreement shall be binding upon the Owner, its heirs, successors, legal representatives and assigns. This Agreement shall run with the title to the Property and shall forever benefit the District and bind the Owner and all future owners of the Property, including without limitation, their heirs, successors, legal representatives and assigns. This Agreement shall be recorded in the property records of Broward County, Florida and will become a legal obligation of the Property in perpetuity.
- 7. Owner for itself and on behalf of all future owners of the Property, hereby agrees to indemnify and hold the District harmless from and against any and all liabilities, damages, claims, costs and expenses, including attorney's fees, which may be imposed upon or asserted against the District arising from or in any way connected with the District's removal of obstructions within the ROW/Easement and/or related to Owner's subsequent maintenance of the ROW/Easement.
- 8. To the extent the terms of this Agreement vary from the District's Right-of-Way/Easement Policy, the terms of this Agreement shall prevail.
- 9. This Agreement may only be amended by written mutual consent of the District and Owner.
- 10. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida. Venue for enforcement of this Agreement shall be in Broward County, Florida.

The District shall not be obligated to remove, at its expense, obstructions placed within the ROW/Easement by Owner subsequent to the execution of this Agreement.
- 4. Subsequent to District's removal of existing obstructions from the ROW/Easement, Owner shall be required to maintain and mow the grassy areas within the ROW/Easement that remain adjacent to his/her property and keep the same free from all structures and growth of vegetation which may become obstructions of the ROW/Easement. 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RESOLUTION 2021-04 SUNSHINE WATER CONTROL DISTRICT TEMPORARY COVID-19 PAID SICK LEAVE POLICY

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, Governor DeSantis issued Executive Order 20-52 declaring a state of emergency of the entire State of Florida pursuant to Chapter 252 of Florida Statutes based upon substantial harm related to COVID-19, which has been extended; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, the District Board of Supervisors declared that the increasing number of cases of COVID-19 in Broward County could result in substantial harm to the District workforce and District operations. For that reason, the District moved to provide paid sick leave to District employees who either tested positive for COVID-19 or were exposed to someone who tested positive for COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, December 23rd, 2020, Governor DeSantis issued Executive Order 20-315, initiating the first phase of vaccine administration. The first phase limited the administration of the COVID-19 vaccine to only elderly populations of the state and health care personnel with direct patient contact; and

WHEREAS, the District finds that until the Governor issues an Executive Order expanding the administration of the COVID-19 vaccine to all people in the state, there remains an ongoing threat of substantial harm to the District workforce and District operations due to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to formally adopt a temporary COVID-19 related paid sick leave policy ("Policy"). Due to the uncertain nature of COVID-19 vaccination availability to District employees, the Policy describes the conditions for District employees to receive paid sick for COVID-19 for the periods before and after the vaccine becomes widely available; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Policy to protect the District workforce and District operations from substantial harm due to COVID-19 and to incentivize District employees to get the Covid-19 vaccination once it is available to them; and

WHEREAS, the District finds this Resolution to be in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE SUNSHINE CONTROL WATER DISTRICT:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The foregoing Whereas clauses are hereby ratified and incorporated as the intent of this Resolution.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The District hereby modifies the personnel policies of the District by adopting the COVID-19 Paid Sick Leave Policy as set forth in Exhibit 1, as attached herein. This Policy will be in effect starting [effective date of temporary policy].
- <u>Section 3</u>. This Resolution shall be effective starting [effective date of temporary policy.

EXHIBIT 1

SUNSHINE WATER CONTROL DISTRICT TEMPORARY COVID-19 PAID SICK LEAVE POLICY

I. PAID SICK LEAVE FOR THE PERIOD BEFORE THE COVID-19 VACCINE IS MADE WIDELY AVAILABLE

- (A) District employees who test positive for COVID-19 will be entitled to paid sick leave without utilization of their accrued sick or vacation time, subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) The employee must provide the District with evidence of a positive COVID-19 test result.
 - (2) The employee will be entitled to full pay based on their regular rate of pay and work schedule for a period not to exceed 14 days within a 12-month period.
 - (3) The employee's accrued sick and/or vacation time must be utilized for any unpaid portion of a COVID-19 related absence from work.
 - (4) The employee must comply with all CDC isolation guidelines in place at the time of the positive test result.
 - (5) Prior to returning to work, the employee must provide evidence of a negative COVID-19 test result.
- (B) District employees who have been exposed to COVID-19 will be entitled to paid sick leave without utilization of their accrued sick or vacation time, subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) The employee must provide the District with written evidence describing their exposure to another individual with COVID-19. The District will determine whether the exposure qualifies for paid sick leave based on CDC guidelines in effect at the time of exposure.
 - (2) The employee will be entitled to half-pay (50%) based on their regular rate of pay and work schedule for a period not to exceed 14 days within a 12-month period.
 - (3) The employee's accrued sick and/or vacation time must be utilized for any unpaid portion of a COVID-19 related absence from work.
 - (4) The employee must comply with all CDC quarantine guidelines in place at the time of exposure.
 - (5) Prior to returning to work, the employee must provide evidence of a negative COVID-19 test result.

II. PAID SICK LEAVE AFTER THE COVID-19 VACCINE IS WIDELY AVAILABLE

(A) Paid sick leave to receive the vaccination: District employees will be entitled to paid sick leave to receive the COVID-19 vaccination without utilization of their accrued sick or vacation time, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The employee must provide the District with written evidence that he or she received the COVID-19 vaccination.
- (2) The employee will be entitled to full pay based on his or her regular rate of pay and work schedule for a period of 1 day for each vaccination shot he or she receives.
- (3) The employee will be entitled to full pay based on his or her regular rate of pay and work schedule for a period not to exceed 3 days for any adverse medical effects he or she may experience as a direct result of receiving the COVID-19 vaccination.
- (B) Vaccinated employees who test positive for COVID-19: District employees who test positive for COVID-19 after receiving the vaccination will be entitled to paid sick leave without utilization of their accrued sick or vacation time, subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) The employee must provide the District with evidence they have been vaccinated and evidence of a positive COVID-19 test result.
 - (2) An employee who tests positive for COVID-19 after receiving the vaccination will be entitled to paid sick leave for two separate diagnoses within a 12-month period. For each diagnosis, the employee will be entitled to full pay based on their regular rate of pay and work schedule for a period not to exceed 14 days.
 - (3) The employee's accrued sick and/or vacation time must be utilized for any unpaid portion of a COVID-19 related absence from work.
 - (4) The employee must comply with all CDC isolation guidelines in place at the time of the positive test result.
 - (5) Prior to returning to work, the employee must provide evidence of a negative COVID-19 test result.
- (C) Non-vaccinated employees who test positive for COVID-19: District employees who test positive for COVID-19 who have not received the vaccination will be entitled to paid sick leave without utilization of their accrued sick or vacation time, subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) The employee must provide the District with evidence of a positive COVID-19 test result.
 - (2) The employee will be entitled to full pay based on their regular rate of pay and work schedule for a period not to exceed 14 days within an 18-month period.
 - (3) The employee's accrued sick and/or vacation time must be utilized for any unpaid portion of a COVID-19-related absence from work.
 - (4) The employee must comply with all CDC isolation guidelines in place at the time of the positive test result.
 - (5) Prior to returning to work, the employee must provide evidence of a negative COVID-19 test result.
- (D) **Employees exposed to COVID-19**: District employees who have been exposed to COVID-19 <u>may</u> be eligible to receive paid sick leave without utilization of their accrued sick or vacation time, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The employee must provide the District with written evidence describing their exposure to another individual with COVID-19. If the employee has been vaccinated, the employee must provide evidence of their vaccination.
- (2) The District will determine whether the exposure qualifies for paid sick leave based on CDC guidelines regarding exposure after the vaccination becomes widely available and CDC guidelines regarding exposure after a person has been vaccinated.
- (3) The District will determine on a case-by-case basis whether to provide paid sick leave, and the amount of pay (50% or full pay) and the number of days of paid sick leave that will be provided to the employee. In no event will the District provide COVID-paid sick leave that exceeds the number of days described in Section (B)(2) for a vaccinated employee or Section (C)(2) for a non-vaccinated employee.
- (4) The employee's accrued sick and/or vacation time must be utilized for any unpaid portion of a COVID-19 related absence from work.
